
Mayor Landrum stated that a Public Hearing is being held to gain input regarding:

Property tax rates proposed to be set by the City of Farmington, a political subdivision. The tax rates shall be set to produce revenues which the budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2015, shows to be required from the property tax. Each tax rate is determined by dividing the amount of revenue required by the current assessed valuation. The result is multiplied by 100 so the tax rate will be expressed in cents per \$100.00 calculation. Tax rates are subject to approval by the State Auditor and may be revised to reflect required changes.

Michelle Daniel, Finance Director, provided an overview of the proposed property tax rate.

Andrew Hamill, 402 Overton, addressed the Council stating that he hopes no City employees lose their job due to the tax change. He also stated that he thinks all traffic tickets should be \$9.99 so the City doesn't get into trouble with the State of Missouri.



Dylan Mosier, City Planner, explained the location of the tract of land and explained it is basically a clean-up item.


