Mayor Forsythe stated that a Public Hearing is being held to gain input regarding:




Brett Burgess explained that there was an error on the original plat and the lot size of one lot is not large enough for a duplex so they are proposing to build a single family home with a double car garage.

He explained that Planning and Zoning gave a favorable recommendation.





Tim Porter, Director of Development Services, explained the final plat which is part of the solar farm.


