Mayor Forsythe stated that a Public Hearing is being held to gain input regarding:



Tim Deason, 617 Quarry Street, addressed the Council stating that he was curious as to what will happen to the newly platted property.


Mr. Beavers explained that the neighboring property's driveway goes through the city's property, so they are giving them the portion that their driveway goes through.
