Public Hearing Minutes of Hearing March 10, 2022 6:00 p.m.

The City Council of the City of Farmington met on March 10, 2022 at Long Memorial Hall, 110 West Columbia Street, Farmington, Missouri 63640.

The hearing was called to order by Mayor Forsythe.

The roll was called with the following Councilors present: David Kennedy, Adam Parks, Chad Follis, Harry Peterson, Wayne Linnenbringer and Chris Morrison.

City Counselor, Scott Reid, was present.

Officials present were Paula Cartee, Tim Porter, Ashley Bischoff, Greg Beavers, Todd Mecey, Rick Baker, Larry Lacy and Travis Trokey.

Mayor Forsythe stated that a Public Hearing is being held to gain input regarding:

An Application for a Final Record Plat at 1212 Weber Road (Case FRP-21-008). The property is currently zoned as "OP-1 Office and Professional District." Submitted by Sharo Shirshekan, East Missouri Action Agency, and the City of Farmington.

Tim Porter, Development Services Director, explained the request.

Mary Hendricks, 1224 Weber Road, addressed the Council regarding her adjoining property line to this location and her attempt to obtain extra property from Mr. Shirshekan for a drain field. She stated that her property is .40 acres and she is needing room to put the drain field in for her well. Prior to a leak issue, she had city utilities.

Scott Reid, City Counselor, stated the City can't make someone sell property to her.

Ms. Hendricks stated that she understood that.

Councilor Follis asked Larry Lacy, Public Works Director, why Ms. Hendricks was on city utilities and couldn't return to that after the leak.


Larry Lacy addressed the Council and stated that he would look into it.
