waiver of trial, plea of guilty, and payment of fine and costs for violations subject to the

limitations hereinafter prescribed. The offenses within the authority of the Clerk are as set

forth in Exhibit "A" but shall not include any violation resulting in personal injury or

property damage.

Any person charged with an offense listed in Exhibit "A" except one resulting in

personal injury or property damage may deliver by mail or otherwise the specified amount

of the fine and costs to the Violation Bureau. Said delivery constitutes a guilty plea and

waiver of trial as provided by Supreme Court Rule 37.49.

A copy of this Order and fine schedule shall be prominently posted at the place where

fines are to be paid.

This Order and the Offenses and Fines set forth in Exhibit "A" shall apply to all

tickets written on or after September 11, 2015. Any and all tickets written August 28, 2015

through September 10, 2015 shall continue to be covered by the order entered August 28,

2015. Any and all tickets written prior to August 28, 2015 shall continue to be covered by

the order entered August 28, 2013.
