BILL 82112014 ORDINANCE 3-70

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, MISSOURI, TITLE VII: UTILITIES, CHAPTER 710: SEWERS BY AMENDING 730.050 OF ARTICLE III: DISCHARGE RESTRICTIONS AND GENERAL PRETREATMENT REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Pursuant to the National Pollutant Discharge Permit issued to the City of Farmington for operation of its waste water system, the City is required to adopt regulations related to the pretreatment of certain commercial and industrial pollutants; and,

WHEREAS, this ordinance sets forth uniform requirements for users of the publicly owned treatment works for the City of Farmington and enables the City to comply with all applicable State and Federal laws, including the Clean Water Act (33 United States Code [U.S.C.] section 1251 et seq.), the General Pretreatment Regulations (Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations [CFR] Part 403) and Missouri Code 10 CSR 20-6.100.

WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources has reviewed the proposed regulations and provided its recommendation for approval; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed regulations have been submitted to the City Council with the affirmative recommendation of the City Administrator and the Public Works Director; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THECOUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Farmington, Title VII: Utilities, Chapter 710: Sewers, Article III. Discharge Restrictions and General Pretreatment Regulations, Section 730.050 C is hereby amended by deleting the existing paragraph C and replacing it as follows:

C. Any waters or wastes containing the following substances to such a degree that the total mass loading from all SIU's exceeds the quantity specified in the table below. The Public Works Director will develop the permit limitations for all users that meet the definition of S.I.U. as defined by City Ordinance. The Table of Masses is as follows:

SECTION 2. That the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section shall be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by valid judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage by the City Council and approval of the Mayor.
