LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT PARTICIPATES IN PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK DAY

Batavia, OH – October 2011. Each year, the U. S. Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Agency holds a National Prescription Drug Take Back Day to provide a venue for persons who want to dispose of unwanted and unused prescription drugs. Clermont County law enforcement agencies are partnering with local coalitions to participate in this event on **Saturday, October 29 from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm**. All prescription and over-the-counter medications can be dropped off at identified sites for free.

National Prescription Drug Take Back Day addresses a vital public safety and public health issue. More than seven million Americans currently abuse prescription drugs, according to the 2009 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration's National Survey on Drug Use and Health. Each day, approximately, 2,500 teens use prescription drugs to get high for the first time according to the Partnership for a Drug Free America. Studies show that a majority of abused prescription drugs are obtained from family and friends, including the home medicine cabinet.

In 2010, 49 Clermont County residents lost their lives to prescription drug overdoses. Substance abuse prevention is a serious issue that is being addressed by two local groups: the Coalition for a Drug-Free Clermont County and Partners for a Drug-Free Milford Miami Township. A first step in prevention is to safely remove unwanted and unused medications from circulation.
