Presentation/discussion of rezoning request for "A" Agricultural zoned property at 6600 Patricia Boulevard by Tom Hudepohl with the Hudepohl Company

➤ Tom Hudepohl made a presentation to the board of the intent to use the existing building for storage of large valuable motor homes. The storage would house about 65 homes in addition to outside storage which would house about 600 units. He would also have a small office. Followed by questions and discussions.

Request for re-platting of lots 31 and 75 in the Villages of Belmont - M/I Homes presented by Matt Walker

Asking for the remaining 6 lots to have an additional reduction in the setbacks. These lots were to accommodate the three story townhome units and once the market turned, M/I was forced to alter their plans and prints in order to sell. Changing these lots from the three story townhomes to the new "ranch style" townhomes. In making these changes the setbacks needs reduced to accommodate the change.after discussion among the board, finding that changing the plans in any other form such as rear yard setback would be compromised by gas lines.

Lee Lewis made a motion to approve the request of variance with the condition that brick facing wraps around from front to side on street sides. Bob Seyfried second the motion
