- Fire and EMS presented by Doug Engled. Year to date information is as follows: EMS participation was 1568 runs. Fire Dept. was 485 calls.
- o Police presented by Chief Ray Snyder. Year to date information is as follows: 20,757 calls and 24,922 total hours worked.
- o Service Department presented by Bill E. Smith. Year to date information is as follows: 54 funerals, 5 cremations, cemetery lot sales \$32,330, cemetery receipts \$40,400.65 and road receipts \$1,122.37.
