Old Business

Building Project Update

Bunnell Hill Construction representative Chris Wiseman gave an update on the progress of the new administration building. The site utilities are in and 80% of the drywall is complete. The scheduled completion date is August 1, 2005.

The following work authorizations were received from Bunnel Hill Construction:

- Number 21 from Geiger Construction for a refund of \$3,700.00 due to duplication in scope. Caulking of windows is included in the caulking bid package.
- Number 22 from ThyssenKrupp Elevators for an additional charge of \$1,844.00 for the installation of elevator without permanent power and for re-mobilization once permanent power is established.
- Number 23 from George Steel for an additional charge of \$1,140.00 for third mobilization of crane to keep job moving.
- Number 24 from George Steel for an additional charge of \$1,600.00 for overtime authorized by Bunnel Hill to help the schedule and re-work of roof frames.

***Lee Lewis made a motion that the Board approve the additional work authorization charges of \$4,584.00 minus the \$3,700.00 refund from work authorization 21 for a total cost of \$844.00. Ed Soergel second-motion carried.

Fischer Homes

Larry Sprage, representative from Fischer Homes and Pete Langhorne, representative from Seasongood and Mayer discussed a TIF with the Board in regards to the Heisler Mill PUD.

Open and Register Audio/Visual System Bids
