Table Approval of January 2, 2006 Minutes

Temporary Appropriations

***Mike Keeley made the motion upon the recommendation of Administrator Ray Snyder that the Board adopt a temporary appropriations budget in the amount of \$385,000.00. T.J. Corcoran second-motion carried.

Set Bond Amount

***Mike Keeley made the motion per the recommendation of Clerk Sandra Graham that the Board set the bond amount for the Trustees at \$10,000.00, and to authorize the clerk to make payment for any related premiums. T.J. Corcoran second-motion carried.

Pay Outstanding Bills

***Mike Keeley made the motion upon the recommendation of Clerk Sandra Graham that the Board approve the payment of any outstanding bills provided that the payment would comply with state auditor requirements related to prior certification of funds. T.J. Corcoran second-motion carried.

Trustees Compensation

***Mike Keeley made the motion that the Board establish that the Trustees will be compensated by salary rather than per diem. T.J. Corcoran second-motion carried.

Remove Restrictions on Citizens in Township Meetings

***Mike Keeley made the motion that the Board remove all restrictions on citizen input at Township meetings. T.J. second-motion carried.
