# **Communications / Announcements**

• Ray Snyder read a communication that was received from Jeremy Evans, Traffic Engineer at the Clermont county Engineer's Office. He reported that the state of Ohio had approved a speed reduction from 50mph to 45mph for Shiloh Road.

\*\*\*T.J. Corcoran made a motion to adopt the following meeting compensation standard for the Zoning Commission and Board of Zoning Appeals as recommended by Lou Ethridge: \$35 flat fee per day for board members attendance of meetings regardless of the number of hearings and

# **Community Forum**

Jeff Corcoran asked about the estimated money lost from the fire dept. Virgil stated there was a typo on the monthly report and he will have it corrected for next meeting.

T.J. Corcoran asked for an update on the gas tax. Lisa Allen explained that the state auditor representative, April Davis, was in and communicated after much research, that we are getting gas tax money from the state and the federal government. It is sent from the county auditor's office and lists both as Gas Tax. It was explained that one is based on a formula and the other is dictated by the agency. Mary Gray, from Lykins Oil, will be meeting with Lisa to explain how BP is processing the taxes for the Township and Lisa will determine what other investigation needs to occur.

T.J. Corcoran asked about the lighting district money. Ray gave an update that Lisa Allen had collected the revenue dollars and submitted it to him. Ray is waiting for Duke Energy to send the remaining documentation.

Lisa Allen communicated that the 2006 audit should begin in the next couple of months.

T.J. Corcoran asked if there was an update on the emergency sirens. Virgil stated that we don't have the money to finance this right now and we are not eligible for any grant money at this time. Virgil said that he would have an update at the next meeting.

Mike Keeley asked about the sign in front of the building. Lou Ethridge suggested we wait until we get more information on what we are doing with the business district. Ray has asked to get an estimate on repair costs for the current sign.

Jeff Corcoran asked when the website would be completed and how the Township will communicate its completion to the public. Ray stated that time has not enabled him to have his part complete. T.J. Corcoran said that we would go ahead and make it live and add to it as we go. Everyone should send Sarah what they have already completed.

Ray Snider gave a recap of July 2007 budget and presented an August 2007 update.
