Mr. Carey stated his apology to Ray Snyder and thanked him for helping apprehend the suspect who took one of his signs down over the week end. It was Ray's brother Michael Snyder. - Janice Walker West Curt Ln Janice felt Jack Carey was a targeted business. All the bad publicity, negative campaigning was created by the township. We all need to work together. Janice gave Ray and Bobby both credit for not slinging mud with everyone else.
- Bob Saylor CPAAA President He spoke about the Christmas Shop with a Police Officer. Last year they were able to help 8 Goshen children and hope to help more this year. We have a 32" TV that is being raffled off at the Holly Fair at 2PM. You can get tickets at Kroger on November 3<sup>rd</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>. You can make a donation by dropping off a

- Steve Holland Goshen Mr. Holland stated that Jack Carey should be done with the township. It was a State problem with the right of way and he should take it up with them. Mr. Holland stated that he was a victim of a squad run this past week and the squad had no heat. These things needs fixed.
