Chairman T.J. Corcoran called the public hearing for Zoning Case #225 of the Goshen Township Trustees to order. T.J. Corcoran-present, Tim Hodges-present, and Mike Keeley-present.

Case #225: The applicant, Centres Inc., is requesting a zone change for two parcels of property totaling 1.30 +/- acres from R-3, medium low density residential to B-2, General Business District. The property is located along the northern side of State Route 28, approximately 900 feet east of the Smith Road/State Route 28 intersection in western Goshen Township. The Clermont County Planning Commission recommended approval. The Goshen Township Zoning Commission also recommended approval.

## **Applicant**

John Korfhagen, legal counsel representing Centres, Inc., went over the project. He explained that the developer has made the decision to upgrade State Route 28 with turn lanes and also to upgrade the intersection. The developer talked to the owner of Cedar Lake Lane and he is receptive to whatever needs to be done.
