## **City Holiday Schedule**

## **SECTION 1. HOLIDAYS**

The following days shall be considered as holidays:

New Years Day (which shall be January 1<sup>st</sup>)

Good Friday (which shall be the first (1<sup>st</sup>) Friday before Easter Sunday

Memorial Day (which shall be the last Monday in May)

Independence Day (which shall be July 4<sup>th</sup>)

Labor Day (which shall be the first (1<sup>st</sup>) Monday in September)

Veterans Day (which shall be November 11)

Thanksgiving Day (which shall be the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) Thursday in November)

The Day after Thanksgiving Day (which shall be Friday after the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) Thursday in November)

Christmas Day (which shall be December 25<sup>th</sup>)

Telecommunicators will substitute Easter Sunday (as determined by each calendar year) as a specified holiday in lieu of Good Friday.

FOR TELECOMMUNICATORS ONLY: The calculation of pay for holidays worked shall be the twentyfour (24) hour period beginning at 7:00 a.m. the day of the holiday and ending at 7:00 p.m. on the day following the holiday.

## SECTION 2. HOLIDAY ON SUNDAYS

When any of the above holidays, as defined in Article VIII, Section 1 of the agreement, fall on Sunday, such Holidays shall be observed on Monday.

## SECTION 3. HOLIDAY ON SATURDAY

When any of the above holidays, as defined in Article VIII, Section 1 of this agreement, fall on Saturday, such holiday shall be observed on Friday.
