

The regular meeting of the Green Township Board of Trustees held on February 9, 2026 was called to order at 5:30 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Trustee Callos, present; Trustee Winkler, excused; Chairman Rosiello, present; Fiscal Officer Straus, present.

Chairman Rosiello moved to approve the minutes for the regular meeting of January 26, 2026. Trustee Callos seconded the motion. All voted Yes.

**RESOLUTION #26-0209-A**

Chairman Rosiello moved to accept and approve the financial reports as submitted. Trustee Callos seconded the motion. The resolution passed unanimously.

**RESOLUTION #26-0209-B**

Chairman Rosiello moved to amend revenue and appropriations for expenses for the Fiscal Year 2026. Trustee Callos seconded the motion. The resolution passed unanimously.

**RESOLUTION #26-0209-C**

Chairman Rosiello moved to approve the sale of a 2012 Ford Horton Ambulance to Riely Township Fire Department for \$4,000. Trustee Callos seconded the motion. The resolution passed unanimously.

Fire & EMS Chief Chris Godfrey stated the 2012 ambulance has been decommissioned.

**RESOLUTION #26-0209-D**

Chairman Rosiello moved to authorize amendment of Conservation Easement. Trustee Callos seconded the motion. The resolution passed unanimously.

Attorney Alex Jones reported on a 2006 conservation easement that now requires an amendment to construct a one lane road.

**RESOLUTION #26-0209E**

Chairman Rosiello moved to regulate the issuance and processing of any permits allowing retail dispensaries, cultivators, or processors of medical marijuana, adult use marijuana, or the combination of both and revising the partial moratorium within Green Township, Hamilton County, Ohio. Trustee Callos seconded the motion. The resolution passed unanimously.

Administrator Frank Birkenhauer reported on a moratorium on medical marijuana dispensaries in retail corridors and the need for updated regulations.

**RESOLUTION #26-0209-F**

Chairman Rosiello moved to accept the bid of \$753,948.17 from John R. Jurgensen Company for the 2026 Street Rehabilitation Contract and the bid of \$359,269.90 from Husac Paving and Excavating Inc for the 2026 Curb Rehabilitation Contract. Trustee Callos seconded the motion. The resolution passed unanimously.

Public Services Director Joe Lambing stated the 2026 Street Rehabilitation Program bid was lower than the estimate.

**Township Attorney Alex Jones reported a need for Executive Session to consider the purchase of property for public purposes.**

**Director of Public Services Joe Lambing reported on water main breaks and winter weather road conditions.**
