

The regular meeting of the Green Township Board of Trustees held on May 26, 2026 was called to order at 5:30 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Trustee Callos, present; Trustee Winkler, present; Chairman Rosiello, present; Fiscal Officer Straus, present.

Chairman Rosiello moved to approve the minutes for the regular meeting of May 11, 2026. Trustee Callos seconded the motion. All voted Yes.

RESOLUTION #26-0526-A

Chairman Rosiello moved to accept and approve the financial reports as submitted. Trustee Callos seconded the motion. The resolution passed unanimously.
