

The regular meeting of the Green Township Board of Trustees held on April 27, 2026 was called to order at 5:30 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Trustee Callos, present; Trustee Winkler, present; Chairman Rosiello, excused; Fiscal Officer Straus, present.

Trustee Winkler moved to approve the minutes for the regular meeting of April 13, 2026. Trustee Callos seconded the motion. All voted Yes.

Trustee Tracy Winkler invited members of the Green Township Police Citizen Academy Alumni Association to the podium to present Police Officer Patrick Enneking with their 2025 Officer of the Year Award.
