



The History of German-Americans in Greater Cincinnati

Join us for a slideshow historical presentation on the many contributions German-Americans have made to the Greater Cincinnati area. The German-American Citizens League maintains the German Heritage Museum on West Fork Road as part of its mission to preserve and promote an awareness of the German heritage. 
