With a mission to enhance the quality of life for indigent elderly adults in Hamilton County, who have been deemed incompetent by Probate Court, the Guardianship Assistance Program for elderly adults, a program offered by nonprofit Cincinnati Area Senior Services (CASS) provides trained guardians to serve as concerned, caring advocates and surrogate decision-makers. As we reflect on the impact of the program and the lives that have been touched, we wanted to share a reflections from Guardians that give insight into their experiences.

Reflections: A lady whom I was guardian, mentioned to the nurse in her nursing home that she was dying soon. The nurse called me and we believed her. She was Catholic so I proceeded to have a priest to anoint her. He was just recently ordained and this was his first time to anoint a person outside the church. I witnessed such love and patience with her in this service. She died the next morning and we proceeded to call her other sister in Indiana who never answered her phone before. With preparation for the funeral and burial, I requested the priest to have the service, he was so wonderful to have the service in the convent chapel with her sister attending as well her niece. St. Mary's Cemetery was gracious to have her burial with a marker without payment....**Sister Adelaide**

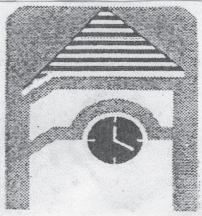
