Annie Oakley (born **Phoebe Ann Mosey**; August 13, 1860 – November 3, 1926, in Willowdell, Ohio) was an American sharpshooter and exhibition shooter. Her amazing talent first came to light at 15 years old, when she won a shooting match, against traveling-show marksman Frank E. Butler, whom she later married. The couple joined Buffalo Bill's Wild West Show a few years later. Oakley became a renowned international star, performing before royalty and heads of state. Annie died November 3, 1926, in Greenville, Ohio.




