On Monday April 1st, at the General Membership Meeting, Allison Detzel, Director of our Senior Center said this to the membership." ... Recently, we've had a few instances of members treating other members inappropriately. This was discussed with the Board and we've decided to share at the membership meeting and the newsletter the consequences for such behavior. Joanne is going to read from Article IX, Membership, Section D of the Constitution and Bylaws."

From the Constitution and Bylaws of the Green Township Senior Citizens Activities, Inc

- Section D. (1) The Board of Directors, by Majority vote, may revoke or suspend the Membership of an individual(s) if just cause is brought before them.
- Section D. (2) Cause for Membership revocation or suspension shall include unacceptable conduct, offensive and improper actions towards other Members, lewd or salacious behavior, thievery, fighting and any actions considered inappropriate and contrary to normal conduct exhibited by other persons of the General Membership.
- Section D. (3) The President, along with at least two (2) Members of the Board, as well as any other parties deemed by the President to be pertinent to the subject circumstances, shall meet with the offending person(s) and explain the decision of the Board that their Membership is, as of that date, formally revoked or suspended for a defined time.
- Section D. (5) The revoked member(s) shall have the right to reapply for membership after one (1) calendar year from the date of revocation of their membership.
- (5a) The Board of Directors must vote to accept or reject their reinstatement at that time prior to their new membership being issued to them. The application fee as well as the annual membership dues shall be required for reinstatement of revoked member(s).


