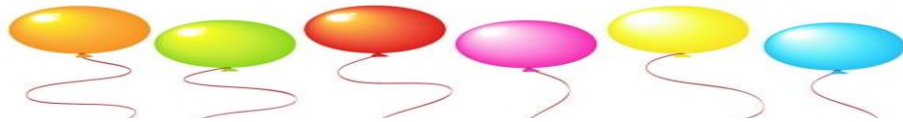
Thursday Night Supper Club

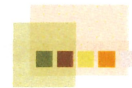

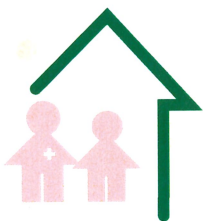

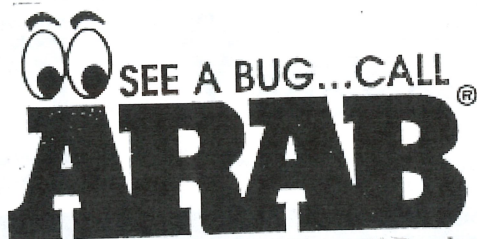
