


The Train Show had a great turnout. One thousand attendees for both days.

### **Increases in the Ticket Costs for the Dances and Dinners for 2019**

<u>DINNERS</u> - At the January Board of Directors' Meeting a good deal of information was discussed and financial data analyzed. The Dec. 10<sup>th</sup> Christmas Dinner lost \$250 plus. In 2018, we served 1,257 dinners costing \$15,363 dollars. The 2018 Dinners sustained a loss of \$1,155 Dollars. If it had not been for LaRosa's and Ron Roost, we would have had an additional loss \$500 dollars or more. For these reasons, we had to increase ticket prices, \$12 (Members) and \$14 (non-Members). Even with these increases, it is projected that the Dinners will still sustain a loss of approximately \$300 dollars in 2019. Membership cards must be shown for every ticket to be purchased.

<u>DANCES</u> – The New Year's Eve Dinner and Dance sustained a loss of \$400 dollars. The major reason was the lack of attendance. Between 80 to 90 attended. This is true for even the monthly dances. Now, the Monthly average attendance is 80 dancers. Sixty percent of those are non-members. To reduce the losses, Nancy has one and is looking for more sponsors. The dance tickets prices are being increased to \$7 (Members) and \$8 (non-Members). <u>Membership cards must be</u> shown at the door.

This Board Meeting left nothing out. Everyone agreed, we cannot keep spending money without your support and cost cutting ideas. Food prices are going up, along with the potential threat of an increase in Catering charges. This financial feeling applies to the Dances. Again, that is why Nancy is seeking sponsors. In the end, changes in prices/charges will only be approved by the Board. Chairpersons will present written requests. <a href="Article XI">Article XI</a> – PLANNED ACTIVITIES Section A. (2) – as stated in the Constitution and Bylaws – Dated 9-11-2017.
