I recall with nostalgia hearing jewels of wisdom, learning to bake, sew, collect eggs from the henhouse and tend to all the farm animals. Some of the most profound lessons I still carry with me today. One day my grandpa took me to the barn where a sow had just given birth to eight piglets. Seven nestled by the sow drinking milk and the 8th lagged behind. I picked it up to take it to its mother and my grandpa said, "Don't do that, Lynne. It has to learn to fend for itself." It was a tough lesson in reality and survival. I didn't understand at the time but later realized his reasoning.

It made me think of the youth today and their obsession with electronic devices. I was concerned that they were missing something earthy and basic about life. But my concerns were put to rest by the experience I had on Sunday. I attended a baseball game with my friend Charlie, as his grandson plays first baseman on the team. It was great fun seeing the expertise and energy of these young men. A down syndrome boy of about 14 dressed in full uniform is the team's bat boy. At the end of the game, the boy went to the plate and was allowed to hit the ball for a home run. The crowd wildly cheered as he ran the bases and crossed home plate breathless and proud. I was so impressed with our youth as they demonstrated compassion, team spirit and good sportsmanship. This young boy saw that even with his disadvantages, simply having the guts and determination he could not only survive but excel in the activities of the world in which he lives. By the way, our team won both games of the doubleheader. It was both talent and poetic justice.

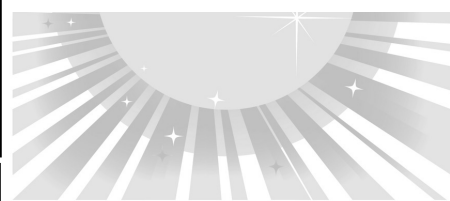
*The Zumba class will be back. We are trying to figure out a new time for the class. Please watch the board for more information.

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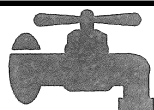

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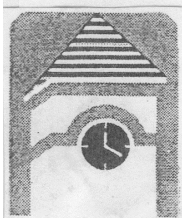
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
