Dinner Ticket prices: Members - \$12.00; Non-Members - \$14.00



Stepping On is a community-based, small-group workshop for people who are: 1) at risk of falling, 2) have a fear of falling, or 3) who have fallen one or more times. The workshops meet for two hours a week for seven weeks. Guest speakers such as Physical Therapists, Optometrists, Pharmacists and Community Law Enforcement will teach Balance & strength exercises and the role vision, medication, and footwear play in falls.
