

Acceptable and Unacceptable recycling materials

Rumpke Recycling accepts all plastic bottles #1-7 in its residential recycling programs. The bottle must have a small mouth with a base wider than the mouth. Typical bottles include milk jugs, soda bottles, laundry detergent bottles, water bottles, shampoo bottles and contact solution bottles.

Unacceptable plastic materials:

Any plastic not in the shape of a bottle is **not acceptable** in Rumpke Recycling's residential programs, such as:

- Plastic bags (i.e. grocery bags)
- Butter tubs or whipped topping tubs
- Plastic plates, cups and utensils
- Food trays, like the ones from frozen meals
- Toys or plastic wrappers/packaging
- Film containers
- Oil jugs

Commonly acceptable paper materials include:

White ledger paper: computer, copy machine and typewriter paper; white ledger pads, adding machine tape
News Quality Papers: newspaper, phonebooks, wide-lined news print

Folders: manila, colored and coated folders

Mail: letters, brochures, advertisements, magazines

Correspondence: legal pad paper, colored paper and message sheets, self adhesive notes, index cards, fax paper

Envelopes: with or without windows, with labels, colored and coated

Computer paper

Brown Papers: brown envelopes, brown grocery bags, cereal boxes, beverage cartons, grey cartons and clean pizza boxes (without grease)

Cardboard Boxes: broken down into 3 feet by 3 feet sections

Unacceptable paper materials:

Text Books: the glue binding contaminates the paper

Candy Wrappers: candy and sugars contaminate the paper

Dirty plates, cups and napkins: these items have food particles contaminating the paper

Facial tissue and paper towels: these items are contaminated

Commonly acceptable metals include:

Aluminum cans: beverage and food cans.

Steel cans: soup, food and aerosol cans.

Unacceptable metals:

Scrap metal (except at Rumpke Recycling buy-back centers)

Pots and pans

Coat hangers

Paint cans

Commonly acceptable glass:

Glass bottles and jars:

Clear

Brown

Blue

Green

Please rinse and remove lids.

Unacceptable glass:

Window glass

Drinking glasses

Fish tanks

Light bulb

Green Township's Curbside Recycling Incentive Program

Recycling at home is easy and convenient with Rumpke Recycling

In an effort to increase curbside recycling, Green Township is sponsoring a curbside recycling incentive program for single-family residences in the Township. Two hundred (200) bins will be made available on a first come, first served basis.

Residents interested in curbside recycling can obtain a Rumpke recycling bin from Green Township, with the Township paying for the first six months of recycling service. Residents who sign up for the program will be required to enter into an agreement that stipulates that they will pay \$2.75 per month (\$16.50) for the next six months of curbside recycling. If the resident chooses to keep the recycling bin after that first year, they will continue to pay for this service.

Rumpke Curbside Recycling provides you with a sturdy recycling container and collects your materials weekly in most locations and transports it to a Rumpke Recycling facility located near your home. Bins can be picked up at the Green Township Department of Public Services office at 6303 Harrison Avenue, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Arrangements can be made to have a bin dropped off by calling 574-8832. Questions can be directed to that number as well.

Curbside recycling is an important component of recycling at home and "going green," and Rumpke Recycling continues to provide innovative methods of making this service convenient and user friendly for residents. Recycling not only saves natural resources and energy, but it also demonstrates how our actions can make a difference in the environment. The processed recyclables are then shipped to end users in carpet, plastic pipe, aluminum can, newsprint, cardboard box and fiberglass insulation manufacturing. The important work you do to recycle materials at home is an investment in our future.
