CALL TO ORDER

Presiding Officer Bob Keith called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

INVOCATION

Presiding Officer Bob Keith gave the invocation.

APPROVE THE AGENDA

Commission Member Bob Cameron made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Commission Member Mary Ann Silvey seconded the motion and the vote of approval was unanimous.

PUBLIC FORUM

Presiding Officer Bob Keith invited the audience to speak on any non-agenda item and/or consent agenda topics. No one requested to speak.

CONSENT AGENDA

Presiding Officer Bob Keith presented the consent agenda and asked if any item should be removed before calling for action.

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End of Consent Agenda.

a. HEARING - REQUEST FROM DIANE PICKENS TO APPEAL A CIVIL CITATION

Diane Pickens of 117 Paramount Way explained that she received a letter informing her that her boat was photographed by the lake surveillance camera breaking wake and without a current boat permit. She further stated letter said it was a warning, but she didn't realize that the warning would become a citation if a permit for her boat was not purchased within 7 days (this was stated in the letter but overlook by Ms. Pickens) Ms. Pickens ask to appeal the citation.

Ms. Pickens boat permit was purchased on 7/2/15 (the letter was delivered on 6/13). A penalty of \$125 was charged since her permit was not purchased within 7 days.

Commissioner members discussed the need for clarification when similar letters are sent out in the future (the letter did not specify if that permit should be purchase with 7 days of the letter be sent or with 7 days of delivery, etc)

After further discussion, Commission Member John Moore made a motion to waive the \$125 penalty. Commission Member Bob Cameron seconded the motion. The vote of approval was unanimous.

With no further items of discussion, Commission Member Bob Cameron made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 5:20 p.m. Commission Member Mary Ann Silvey seconded the motion and the vote of approval was unanimous.
