

RESOLUTION 18-04-10

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION AND AVAILABILITY OF LOCAL MATCH FOR THE PURCHASE OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 176 BOYS CAMP ROAD BY THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund, established in 1994 by the North Carolina General Assembly and administered by the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund Authority, provides funding for grants to local governments to purchase and develop parks and recreational projects to serve the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Lake Lure realizes that the purchase of the property at 176 Boy's Camp Road is necessary to better meet the recreational and safety needs of the citizens and visitors to Lake Lure; and

WHEREAS, it is believed that the Board of Commissioners, with the assistance of the general public, is now in a position to approve and lend full support to the purchase of the property at 176 Boys Camp Road property for recreational purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Lake Lure Board of Commissioners:

- 1. Approves the filing of an application for the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund program to the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund Authority and the State of North Carolina, for purchase of the recreational property at 176 Boy's Camp Road; and
- 2. Certifies that the Town of Lake Lure has budgeted or currently has available its 50% share of the proposed total project funds and will allocate these funds toward this project upon project approval by the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund Authority and the State of North Carolina; and

- 3. Agrees to comply with all appropriate state and federal regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements as they relate to the application and the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund program; and
- 4. Certifies the information contained in the application is based on the most accurate data available and is correct.
