General Meeting Actions

- a. Call to Order Chairman Wayne Hyatt called the meeting to order at 2:00 pm.
- b. Approval of March 7, 2017 Minutes Steve Miller made a motion to approve the Minutes of March 7, 2017 as presented. John Chapman seconded and the motion carried 6 0.

Old Business

a. Skyrunner Presentation by Jon Wood – Jon Wood gave a presentation about Skyrunner and their service offerings and plans to extend fiber to every home in Lake Lure. Mr. Wood also discussed the process needed to be undertaken by the Town to complete the work including developing a Request for Proposals, completing an engineering study, and exploring and applying for public funding. Mr. Wood felt that once the engineering study was completed and funding in place, fiber deployment would begin in phases and be completed rather quickly. Following the presentation, the Board asked questions of Mr. Wood and discussed the proposal by Skyrunner of extending fiber to every home.

Pangaea representatives, Russ Pitts and Ken Griffin, spoke about the high cost of extending fiber to every home and the complexities of completing the project within

the projected timeframe. Mr. Pitts expressed support for finding better ways to partner with Skyrunner, developing a county wide approach to improving service, and finding a provider to help fill the service gap in Lake Lure.

Keith Conover, representative of the State of North Carolina Broadband Infrastructure Office, then spoke about available funding for broadband deployment through various state and federal programs.

b. Greenline Update and Review – Town Manager Ron Nalley gave a brief report on the Greenline Project noting that everything was moving forward as planned and that the Town and engineering firms were still on track to meet the proposed deadlines.

a. Open Discussion/Comments - There were no further comments at this time.
