

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE, N. C., FEBRUARY 19, 1929.

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, North Carolina, was held in the Administration Building in said Town on February 19, 1929, the following members being present, to-wit:

L. C. Cobb, Mayor and S. V. Hooker, Commissioner.

The bond given by the Interstate Amiesite Company guaranteeing the streets where amiesite is laid, for a period of five (5) years, was presented to the board, and on motion duly made and seconded, the board accepted said paving and authorized and requested the Clerk to issue check for \$14, 204.35 in full payment of said Amiesite.

Upon motion made and seconded, the Clerk was authorized and directed to issue check in amount of \$50.00 to Mr. F. B. Logan, Commissioner, to cover expenses incurred by him in attending meetings of the Board of Commissioners of the Town for a period of approximately twelve months.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, Mr. Hooker was asked to make a final check on the crushed stone purchased from Chimney Rock Mountains, Incorporated, in order that we may complete settlement for same; and Mr. Hooker was further asked to report to this Board immediately upon completion of the said check.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
