The regular monthly meeting of the Mayor and Town Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure was held in the office of the Mayor on the 21st. day of March, 1933, at which were present the Mayor and the entire Board of Commissioners.

It was decided by the Board that the regular biennial election for the Town of Lake Lure should be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in May of this year, and that a registrar and judges for said election should be appointed.

It was, therefore, upon motion of Miss F. A. Marsh, which was seconded by J. A. Vess, unanimously ordained that Mrs. H. C. Keeter be appointed Registrar for said election, and Walter Leiter and W. H. Lyle be appointed Judges for said election; said judges being of different political parties, of good character, and able to read and write.

It was further ordained that said election should be held in Room #4 in the Administration Bldg., in the town of Lake Lure, and that the same should be held according to the provisions of law for the holding of municipal elections, and that the Mayor of the Board, to-wit: J. T. Arnett, be authorized and directed to make publication of the appointment of the said Registrar and Judges and of the time of the holding of said election by posting a notice thereof at the door of the voting place/and three other public places/ where the election shall be held, and that he shall cause a notice of their appointment to be served upon the aforesaid Registrar and Judges by the sheriff of Rutherford County.


It was further ordained that the registration books shall be revised by the Registrar as provided by Sections 2657, 2658 and 2659 of the Code of North Carolina, and acts amendatory thereto.


It was further ordained that the Judges and Registrar herein appointed shall take the oath of office as provided by Section 2661 of the Code of North Carolina, and acts amendatory thereto.

It is further ordained that the polls shall be open and closed and that the said election shall be conducted as provided by Sections 2664, 2665 and 2666 and 2667 of the Code and other sections of same relating thereto and the amendments to same.

It was moved and seconded that the tax collector be authorized and is directed to make the necessary corrections in taxes of Walter Leiter and D. W. Foster, Heirs, to conform with the county listing. Also to relieve these accounts, when paid, of all penalties and interests due to the errors existing therein.

Upon motion and second, the meeting was adjourned.
