A special meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure was held on Tuesday, August 29, 1939, at which the following business was transacted:

Upon motion of Comm. Vess and seconded by Comm. Greig, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, the town clerk has prepared and submitted to the Board of Commissioners at this meeting a tentative budget for the fiscal year of the town beginning July 1, 1939 and ending June 30, 1940, which has been duly considered and tentatively accepted by the Board;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Clerk is directed to cause a summary of said budget to be published in the next issue of the Rutherford County News, said publication to be one time and to be in the following words and figures:

"The Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure have caused to be prepared a tentative budget for the fiscal year of the Town beginning July 1, 1939 and ending June 30, 1940, a summary of which is published below. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforementioned tentative budget be filed with the Town Clerk for public inspection for at least twenty days following the above publication ordered.

Commissioner Vess offered the following resolution, and moved its adoption, to-wit:

WHEREAS, a number of individuals owning lands adjoining Lake Lure have constructed and are now using boat houses, piers and plat-forms for docking boats; the same being constructed by permission of the lake owners; and

WHEREAS, said persons fishing in Lake Lure frequently trespass upon said property by fishing from said boat houses, docks and piers and by anchoring boats to the same, thereby infringing upon the rights of said property owners;

BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED that it shall be unlawful for any person, without the written permission of the owners thereof, to fish or go in or upon any boat house, pier or dock belonging to another, or so near thereto as to interfere with the owners' possession of the same, and any person violating the terms of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars or imprisonment for thirty days.

Commissioner Greig second the motion to adopt the foregoing resolution, and upon unanimous vote, the same was adopted.

Upon motion and second, meeting was adjourned.
