At a special meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, held on Tuesday, July 30th, 1940, the following proceedings were had:

Upon motion and second, it was ordered by the Board that Comm. J. A. Vess be appointed to examine and report any unapproved accounts to the Board of the monies expended by the Secretary-Treasurer of the town for a period 65 four months effective July 1st. 1940 and that the said examination and approval be held prior to each regular monthly meeting of the Board.

The Board approved the appointments of the Meade M. Simmons and Williard Searcy as special policemen of the Town for special duty without compensation until such time as the Board sees fit to continue.

Commissioner Vess offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

"BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure that the ordinances of the town heretofore adopted on June 6, 1936, be amended as follows:

That sections 1 and 2 and their sub-sections, of the Boating Regulations be changed to read as follows:

1. No. person, firm, or corporation shall operate a commercial boat, or permit any boat owned by such person, firm or corporation, upon said lake within the corporate limits of said town until he shall obtain a license for said purpose from the Secretary-Treas. of said Town, complying with all regulations as to such boats and pay to him the following fees:

(a) \$25.00 for lecense to operate each passenger boat for hire, per season

(b) \$10.00 for license to operate each fishing boat for hire per season.

2. No. person, firm or corporation shall operate a private boat upon said lake, withing the corporate limits of the Town, until he shall obstain a license for said purpose from the Sec. Treas. of said town, and shall pay to him the following fees:

(a) For license to operate a row boat or cance, gog per day or \$2.00 per season.

(b) For license to operate any gasoline or electric propelled boat not exceeding 20 feet in length, 50% per day or \$4.00 per season.

(c) For license to operate any gasoline or electric propelled boat exceeding 20 feet in length, \$6.00 per season.

3. Any person or ownder allowing a private boat to be operated for rental or commercial purposes shall be subject to having such licenses recinded by the town and subject to a fine of \$10.000 for each violation. 4. That this ordinance shall be in effect after this date.

Commissioner Greig Seconded this motion and aftervote was unabimously adopted by the Board.

Upon motion and second meeting was adjourned.
