TOWN OF LAKE LURED

At a regular monthly meeting of the Mayor and Board of Commissions of the Town of Lake Lure, held in the Mayor's office on Tuesday, February 4th. 1941, Commissioner N. A. Greig offered the following resolution and moved its adoption, to-wit;

WHEREAS, it is for the best interest of the citizens of the Town of Lake Lure that public bowling alleys and public pool rocms be prohitited within the corporate limits of said Town:

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to construct, erect, operate or maintain a public bowling alley or pool room within the corporate limits of the Town of Lake Lure;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that any bowling alley or pool room, at which a charge is made for the privilege of bowling or playing pool, shall be construed a public bowling alley or pool room;

BE IT FURIHER RESOLVED that any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance by operating eith by himself, itself, or by an agent, or by an agent of lessee any such bowling alley or pool room within the corporate limits of said Town, shall be subject to a fine of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars per day for each day said bowling alley or pool room is operated, and each day of said operation shall constitute a new and separate offense under the terms hereof.

Commissioner, Washkurn seconded the adoption of the fore-going ordinance, and upon vote the same was unanimously adopted and declared to be in full force and effect from and after the 4th. day of February, 1941.

Commissioner Washburn off ered the following resolution and moved its adoption, to-wit:

WHEREAS, the operation of public open air theatres and shooting galleries within the corporate limits of the Town of Lake Lure should be regulated and the owners and operators of same should be received to obtain permits for the operation thereof;

BE IT WHEREFORE RESOLVED that any person, firm or corporation desiring to senstruct, operate or maintain a public opern air theatre, or shooting gallery within the corporate limits of the Town of Lake Lure, before constructing or operating the same, shall first apply in writing to the commissioners of said Town for a permit to be issued by the Town for the operation thereof, and shall be required to provide and set forth in writing in said application the following information; First, the location at which it is proposed to construct, maintain, or operate the said open air theatre, or shooting gallery. Second, the size, character and construction of the building on which the same is to be operated. Third, the name of the person or poersons who shall be in charge or custody of the said amusement, days of the week and the hours of the day or night when the same will be operated. Fourth, such other information as the Board may, from time to time, prescribe or require.
