NORTH CAROLINA ) RUTHERFORD COUNTY ) TOWN OF LAKE LURE )

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners held on Tuesday, January 6, 1942, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, a seriouse National emergency now exists in the United States, which effects all the people of the United States, the individual sataes, and all the municipalities therein; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Lake Lure has located within its corporate limits a lake, power dam, and power plant; and

WHEREAS, it is the purpose and  $s \neq desire$  of the officials e of the said Towh of Lake Lure to cooperate with the National Government in every way possible in the defense of the <sup>N</sup>ation; and

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of opinion of the officials of said Town that sme 2 regulations and precautions should be taken by the Town to prevent sabotage and to prevent othe subversive and dangerous and unlawful conduct within the corporate limits of the said Town; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient, in order to promote and safeguard the said power plant, that motor boats be prohibited to operate upon the waters of Lake Lure from sundown in the afternoon until sumrise in the forenoon, and to prohibit the ise of said Lake by any corporation or individual near the dam impounding the waters of said Lake Lure, and to prohibit persons who are not duly authorized by the owners of said power plant to visit or come mear to or in close proximity to said dam and power plant:

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED that it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to operate, or cause to be operated, either by hand or motor power, or otherwise, any motor boat, barge, float or other object upon the waters of Lake Lure from sundown in the afternoon until sunrise in the forenoon, or to operate the same at any time within the inlet extending down to the dam and for a distance of \_\_\_\_\_\_ feet from said dam.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that it shall be unlawful for any person not properly and legally authorized by the owners of said dam to loiter around the said dam or power plant or to approach the same unless for legitimate business reasons and purposes, and this prohibition shall extend for a distance of feet in all directions from said dam and power plant.

And for the purpose of carrying into effect the foregoing provisions and the matters and things set forth in the preamble therto, the police officers of the said town are hereby authorized and empowered to apprehend and bring before any court in Rutherford county, having jurisdiction of the same, any person guilty of violating any of the foregoing ordinances, and shall have authority to arrest and bring before said court for investigation any suspicious person whom the may reasonably suspect of being guilty of violating any of the foregoing provisions, and to take all such action as may be expedient and proper for the protection of said Lake and dam which may be necessary for the National welfare in the present emergency, and to lay off and mark or designate said protected area near said dam, and to fully patrol said Lake.

BE ITFURTHER ORDAINED that any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars or imprisonment for a period of thirty (30) days.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall be published by posting a copy of same at the Mayor's office in the Towh of Lake Lure for thirty (30) days, and that the same shall be in effect from and after December 16, 1941.

Upon motion and second and by unanimous vote of the Board the above resolution was formally adopted.
