Riddick, said Tax Collector be and he is hereby instructed and directed to proceed at once to advertise and sell on Monday, September 9th, 1946, according to law, all real estate listed for taxes in the Town of Lake Lure for the year 1945 of persons and corporations whose taxes are not paid on or before that date.

AND, WHEREAS, in order to raise the necessary revenue for the foregoing appropriated expenditures, it is necessary that the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure to levy a tax rate for the fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that there shall be levied and collected in accordance with existing laws a tax upon all real Estate situated in the Town of Lake Lure and upon all personal property owned by the residents of the Town, a rate of \$1.25 per \$100 valuation of said properties, the said tax being necessary to raise the required revenues for the General Fund appropriated and designated herein.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Town Clerk and Tax Collector is hereby instructed to allow such discounts and to charge and collect such

penalties upon such taxes, if and when paid, as are set forth in Section 805 of the Machinery Act of 1933 and all subsequent laws pertaining thereto.

NORTH CAROLINA RUTHERFORD COUNTY TOWN OF LAKE LURE

At a special meeting of the Mayor and Town Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, North Carolina, held on Tuesday, August 27, 1946, the following resolution was offered, and, upon second, was unanimously passed by the Board:

WHEREAS, it is necessary that some regulations be adopted by the Town of Lake Lure, regulating the speed of automobiles upon Federal Highway No. 74 through the corporate limits of said town:

BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED that the speeds fixed and indicated by the signs erected by the State Highway Commission be and the same are hereby adopted and made a part of this ordinance:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a speed limit of the said town, between the intersection of Washburn Road just East of the public school building with Highway \$74, to the bridge across Broad River near the Western limits of said town, shall be Twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

Any person firm or corporation driving any motor vehicle more than twenty-five (25) miles anchour upon said Highway between the two points hereinbefore mentioned, shall be guilty of a violation of this ordinance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any person, firm or corporation violating the terms of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$50.00, or imprisonment of not more than thirty (30) days, UNLESS a different penalty is fixed by the laws of the State of North Carolina, in which event the penalty fixed by the State of North Carolina, in which event the penalty fixed by the State law shall prevail.

THIS ORDINANCE shall be in force from and after September 1, 1946.
