At a special meeting of the Mayor and Board of Commissioners, held on the 10th. of May, 1949, the following business was transacted:

It was moved and seconded, that a written request be presented to the Sheriff of Rutherford county to assign adequate law enforcement help to properly enforce law and order at the Dance Hall and other adjacent areas of the Town of Lake Lure, as assistance to the town's police force.

The following resolution was offered by Comm. Allison, the same being duly seconded and adopted:
