At a special meeting held by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, held on Tuesday, March 28, 1950, the following business was transacted:

The Town Clerk reported to the Board that the $1\frac{1}{4}$ Ton, 1934 Ford truck was unusable and should be disposed of and that the $1\frac{1}{2}$ Ton, 1942 Ford truck was badly in need of repairs and would not be adequate to do the Town's maintenance work this summer and that it would be absolutely necessary that some type of new equipment be acquired as soon as possible; and

That anticipating the need of such equipment, he had asked several Truck Dealers to submit prices on trucks. After examining three bids, the Board found that the Cline-Moore Auto Sales of Rutherfordton, N. C. had offered the town the lowest price, the same being \$2,250.00 for F6 Ford Truck, 2-ton, 158" Cab & Chassis, Booster brakes, 2 speed rear axle and a Daybrook A-5+ 3-4 yd. Hoist body.

After due consideration the Board decided that it was necessary to make the above purchase and authorized the Town clerk to purchase same from the Cline-Moore Auto Sales and to pay the sum of \$1,000.00 on this date and to obligate the town to pay the balance of \$1,250.00 with interest on July 1, 1950, beginning of the new fiscal year.

Upon motion and second, the abowe was unanimously adopted.
