

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE, NORTH CAROLINA, HELD IN THE TOWN  
OFFICE ON JUNE 18, 1952 at 10 O'CLOCK A.M.

At a special meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the  
Town of Lake Lure, N.C. held in the Town Office at Lake Lure,  
North Carolina on the 18th Day of June 1952 at 10 o'clock A.M.,  
the following were present.

A waiver of notice of said meeting was read and ordered  
attached to these minutes.

On motion duly made by Mr. Wm. C. Allison, after discussion of  
of a system for properly handling and policing the operation  
of all boats on the lake, and seconded by Mr. L.M. Pearson, Jr.,  
the following Resolution was unanimously adopted.

That it shall be unlawful to operate upon the waters of  
Lake Lure any and all boats of whatever class, cruisers, skiffs,  
canoes, or sail boats either with or without power, without  
having displayed a number so that identification may be easily  
determined. That the numbers must be provided by said boat  
operators and satisfactorily affixed according to regulations  
provided by Lake warden. That failure to observe this rule  
shall be punishable by loss of privilege license and/or a fine  
of not exceeding \$ 25.00 or both in the discretion of the Court.

That it shall be unlawful to lay against or tie to either of the  
public piers or docks for a longer period of time than one hour.  
That this shall apply to all boats of whatever kind or description  
with or without power. That failure to observe this rule shall  
subject the offender to the loss of his privilege license and /or  
a fine of \$ 25.00 or both in the discretion of the Court.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the  
meeting adjourned.
