At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. held in the Town Office in Lake Lure, N.C. at 7.30 o'clock P.M. Tuesday June 8,1954, the following were present-

The meeting was called to order by the mayor,L.M.Pearson,Jr.

It was suggested by the mayor, L.M. Pearson, Jr. that the Town sponsor a school in Life Saving with especial emphasis on the proper use of the Resuscitator which is owned by the Town. The Clerk was instructed to contact the proper authorities of the Red Cross in an effort to have them cooperate with us on this proposition. It was ,also, suggested that later a drive would be made to raise approximately \$250.00 to purchase another resuscitator. We have a balance of approximately \$180.00 from funds raised for the purchase of the resuscitator we now own.

Commissioners Eudy brought up the matter of constructing proper housing over the new well recently drilled. Mayor Pearson agreed to take the matter up with Mr. J.R.Washburn and arrange for the building of such house.

The matter of purchasing an airefier for use at Golf Course was brought up by Mr. Eddy. It was brought out that we might buy a used one for \$350.00 as against \$650.00 for a new one. After some discussion, the Board decided to rent such equipment at not over \$25.00 per day. The work can be done in one day and the machine to be used once a month for the 4 summer months.

Some discussion was had regarding the suit on Town's Defaulted Bonds which comes up for trial in the Federal Court at Asheville in July, and the mayor is to contact Mr. Hamrick, Town Attorney, as to the status of the matter.

 $\mbox{Mr. V.T.}\, \mbox{Salter}$ was recognized and he discussed the proposed matter of equipment for golf course.

Larry Phillips advised the Board that he had constructed stalls for use of bathers and asked for permissione to hang small signs along the fence fronting lake directing the public to the bath house. This request was granted.

No further business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
