At a Special Meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure held in the Town Office at 7.30 P.M. Monday the 28th Day of June, 1954, the following were present-

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor, L.M. Pearson, Jr. who presented the attached petition signed by 32 residents requesting that the Board provide for 24 hour police protection during the summer months. The Board agreed to provide such service and the several members are to contact Mr. Hague Kiser who has been serving as an extra policeman three days weekly and if agreement is made to name Mr. Kiser for the three summer months as night policeman. It was ordered that a rope be extended from each corner of the old platform or diving board to the beach shore in order to mark the swimming area and turn boats away. On motion duly made and passed, it was provided that no signs of any nature may be placed on that circle immediately fronting the Lake Lure Hotel property known as circle # 3. At a regular Meeting May 11, 1954- Page 89- it was agreed to rent space for the operation of ponies for riding children. Some objection was made by Mr. Rommel of the use of that part of the Beach owned by Carolina Mt. Power Corp. It was, therefore, decided, to permit the operation of this concession on property belonging to the Town of Lake Lure across Pool Creek adjacent to the space used by the rides presently operated by a Mr. Johnson. Mr. S.A. Eudy, Commissioner expressed his objection but it was so ordered.

At the regular meeting June 8, 1954- Page 91- it was agreed to rent an airflier at \$25.00 per day for 4 days during the summer months. Mr. Eudy and Mr. Allison decided later that it should be purchased for the sum of \$350.00 payable \$50.00 monthly. The purchase to be made of E.J. Smith & Sons, Charlotte, N.C. The mayor, L.M. Pearson, Jr., requested that he be recorded as voting against such purchase.

The Clerk was authorized to purchase an electric fan for office use. No further business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
