

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE
TOWN OF LAKE LURE, N.C. HELD IN THE TOWN OFFICE IN LAKE LURE, N.C.
TUESDAY SEPT. 11, 1956 AT 7.30 P.M.

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. held in the Town office at 7.30 P.M. Tuesday Sept. 11, 1956, the following were present.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor, L.M. Pearson, Jr.

The matter of the pump at Well No. 1 was discussed. It appears that oil has been seeping through and into the water. Mr. Wilson is trying to pump water from the well in the hope that this trouble may be corrected. If this doesn't correct the trouble and pump cannot be fixed it may become necessary to purchase another pump.

The question of constructing a Town Office was brought up and after discussion motion was made and seconded and unanimously adopted that the Town begin immediately to proceed with plans for the erection of a Town Office. It was brought out that such a building was provided for in the budget adopted by the Town for 1951-1952 and that there is the sum of \$4,000.00 in hand now earmarked for such purpose. Mr. Pearson will draw the plans at no cost to the Town and after approved, bids will be advertised for. The site for the buildings is to be decided upon later.

Mr. Hamrick is to ascertain if the Town is liable for a tax to the U.S. Govt. for membership cards issued to members of the Golf Club. No such cards were issued for the calendar year 1956.

The following ordinance, upon motion made, seconded and unanimously carried, was passed-

"Resolved that it shall be unlawful to hunt within the corporate limits of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. Any person violating this ordinance shall be fined \$50.00 or imprisoned for 30 days or both in the discretion of the Court; and That the officials of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C., including the Police Department, take all necessary action to enforce this ordinance for the protection of the residents of Lake Lure, N.C. and their property."

It was ordered that the above ordinance be published in the Forest City Courier and the Rutherford County News.
