The mayor, L.M.Pearson, Jr. called the meeting to order and recognized Mrs. Whitson Edwards. Mrs. Edwards presented a proposition with photos and cuts to furnish the Town with folders for advertising.

The Board agreed to purchase 10,000 at On motion duly adopted the Clerk was authorized to pay \$50.00 to the C.R.Civic Club as a donation to the March 30 and 31st Hill Climb and Barbecue. The charge to be to advertising.

Mr. Robet. H.Cooke, C.P.A., who has audited the Town Books for the past 5 years submitted an offer of \$212.00 to do the work again this year. This is the same amount we have been paying. The offer was accepted and contract approved and signed. On motion of Commissioner Gresley, duly seconded by Commissioner Franks and unanimously adopted, the following resolution was passed.

BE IT RESOLVED by the board of commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C., that in accordance with the General Laws of the State of North Carolina, the board of Commissioners hereby calls for an election to be held in the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. on Tuesday May 7th, 1957, the date established by Law for said election. Said election shall be conducted for the purpose of electing a Mayor and Two (2) Commissioners by the voters of the Town. The Mayor and each Commissioners shall be elected to hold office for a term of two (2) years and until their successors are elected and qualified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the polling place shall

be The Town Office in the Town of Lake Lure, N.C.

BE IT FURTHER resolved that Clyde W. Keeter be and is hereby appointed as Registrat; that William Keller and Sidney Nelon be and they are hereby named as Judges of election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all persons eligible to vote in the Town of Lake Lue, N.C., as defined by General Law, shall be eligible to register and vote in the election herein called.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Registrar be and he is hereby directed to open the registration Books for the purpose of recording therein the names of all persons eligible to be registered who did not register for the last preceding municipal election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE Registrar shall open said Books at 9 A.M. Saturday April 13,1957 and ending on Saturday April 27,1957 -Sundays excepted-for the registration of any new electors entitled to register. The Books shall remain open each day during the two(2)weeks from 9.A.M. to Simplify daily save that on Saturdays the Books shall remain open until 9 P.M.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Saturday April 27,1957 shall be designated as Challenge Day and that any person desiring to challenge any name included in said registration Book shall on this day advise the Registrar and Judges of the fact. The Registrar and Judges shall thereupon set a date and time for the hearing of the challenge and said date shall be prior to Monday May 6.1957

FILE SHALL BE 12 NOON WEDNESDAY APRIL 24.1957

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE POSTED AT THE TOWN OFFICE.

The foregoing resolution was unanimously adopted by the BOA RD of Commissioners at a regular meeting tuesday March 12,1957.

Upon motion made by Commissioner Gresley, seconded by Commissioner

Franks, and unanimously carried, it was

RESOLVED, THAT in the opinion of the Board, it is necessary and expedient that the Town of Lake Lure, N.C., should have a new registration of voters prior to the Town election o be held on Tuesday May 7,1957. It is, therefore, ordered that a new registration of all the voters of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. be held prior to the election, which as designated by Law, will take place on May 7,1957.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the registration books shall be open for registration of voters from 9 A.M. until sunset on each day (Sunday excepted) for the two-week period commencing Saturday April 13th,1957 and ending Saturday April 27,1957 and that the Two Clerk cause notice of this order to be posted in three (3) public places within the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. at least thirty (30) days before April 13,1957, said notice to state definitely the location of polling place and registration places and the name of the registrar.

Notice is hereby given that a new registration of all the voters of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. has been ordered by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. The new registration of voters will be held prior to the Town election, which as designated by Law, will take place on May 7,1957. The registration books will be open for registration of voters at KEETER'S ESSO SERVICE STATION on each week day except SATURDAY and on SATURDAYS at the Town Hall from 9 A.M. until Sunset, (Sundays excepted) for the two-week period commencing Saturday April 13,1957 and ending Saturday April 27,1957. The registrar of voters will be Clyde W.Keeter. Any person not registered under this new registration will not be a qualified voter and therefore, will not be privileged to vote in the may 7th,1957 election.
