

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE, WAS HELD IN THE TOWN OFFICE AT  
12:00 O'CLOCK NOON, WEDNESDAY MAY 6, 1959.

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The minutes of a special meeting of April 18, 1959 were read and approved by the "Old Board", this special meeting was to discuss the Attorney Fee, relative to the Bond Suit and Refinancing Plan for the Town of Lake Lure. Minutes of this special meeting have been included in the Minute Book.

J. Paul Wilson made a motion that C. Roy Smith be paid and additional \$100.00 for services rendered in the Beach House for the season of 1958 & 1959. The motion was carried. The clerk was instructed to give Mr. Smith a check sometime during the summer season, when funds are available.

New Business

A report of the results of the Municipal Election held May 5, 1959 was presented by the registrar, Clyde W. Keeter, duly signed by the Registrar and the two Judges, Lewis McKee and Eugene Melton. The report showed that the votes had been duly canvassed with the following results:

Larry Phillips ... 12 Votes

J. Paul Wilson having received the majority vote was declared elected Mayor of Lake Lure.

W. E. Franks, Sr. and Sidney E. Nelson having received the highest number of votes were duly declared elected Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C.

J. Paul Wilson was duly sworn into Office by the Town Clerk, the Mayor then gave the Oath of Office to the each of the elected Commissioners.

No other business the meeting adjourned,. The regular meeting of the Board will be held May 12, 1959, in the Town Hall at 7:30 P.M.
