

The Regular Meeting Of The Board Of Commissioners
Of The Town Of Lake Lure Was Held Novemebr 24, 1959
At 7:30 P.M. In The Town Hall.

The Mayor called the meeting to order.
The Minutes of the October Meeting were read
and approved.

The Board reread the Resolution with reference to
Pony Rides in Corporate Limits of the Town of Lake Lure.
The Clerk was instructed to have Mr. Cal Wilson, Lake
Lure Police inform Mr. C. F. Craig that the Pony Rides
would have to be moved by Janaury 1, 1960.

New Boat & Fishing permits were discussed for the
1960 season. Changes in size and color were advised for
boat permits, Season Boat Permits, Blue, with more speci-
fic information of boat, motor and address of owner.
Information will coincide with State Motor Boat License.

The Clerk read a letter from a number of Lake Lure
residents requesting that some action be taken to curb
week end camping on camping on Lake Lure, the letter
state that campers did not have proper toilet facilities
and left camping areas littered with garbage or threw same
into Lake. The letter also requested that the City Council
restrict the Lake property owners. After some discussion of
the letter, the Board agreed to have the Lake Patrol to keep
a thorough check on campers and post camping spots on the
Lake, also campers must have permission of property owners
for camping. No action was taken on boat request.

The Board unanimously agreed to give Mr. Pye \$25.00
per month for expenses, to take care of extra insurance and
tires, etc.

The Clerk was refunded \$42.74 for expense incurred
in Tax listing.

No other business the meeting adjourned,.
