Manly Swarringen met with the Board and discussed the Operation of the Golf Club House, Mr Swarringen said, he would like to have the job and would live in the Club House and would make every effort to carry out the instructions of the Town Board in the Operation of the Club House. No action was taken on this application.

Mr. W.R. Hackett, Jr. a representative from the Hickory Nut Gorge Civic Club ask the support of the Town in the forth coming clean-up campaign for the entire Gorge. The Board unanimously offered the Town Truck with two men to help in the campaign. The date of the clean-up drive will be April 30, Saturday.

Mr. Justus of the Justus Sand And Gravel Co., of Dana, N.C. met with Town Board to discuss a lease on the Sand Rights on the river and the Lake. No action was taken on the discussion but was deferred until a later meeting.

The Board discussed the Timber Sale which was held on March 4. The highest bid of \$6,800.00 by C.S. Dalton was rejected, The Board agreed that the boundry of Timber and Pulpwood is worth more than this bid. The Clerk was instructed to write Mr. Dalton of the Boards decision and return his check which he deposited with the Clerk.

A Re-sale of the Same Boundry of Timber and Pulpwood will be held at the Town Office Saturday April 2, at 12 o'clock, Noon.

Current bills were approved to be paid.
