

The Regular Meeting Of The Board Of Commissioners of
Town Of Lake Lure Met Tuesday July 12, 1960 In The
Town Hall, 7:30 P.M.

Present were :

The Mayor called the meeting to order, minutes of the
June meeting were read and approved as read.

The first item of business was the reading and approval
of the Budget for the Fiscal Year of 1960-1961. The Clerk
presented the Budget to the Board which was unanimously
accepted.

The Board of Commissioners proffered a \$25.00 raise for the
Clerk. The Clerk accepted, graciously.

The Board ask the Clerk to instruct the Lake Lure Police to
keep the Geneva Motor Court Driveway free of parked cars on
Saturday nights during the dances at the Riverside Pavilion.
Also inform Mr. Smith that to close the dance promptly at 11:
45 P.M.

A motion was made and approved to give the Beach House workers
a \$5.00 bonus for the 4th of July week.

A letter was read from the Golf Course Greens Committee re-
commending the following fees for the Golf Course:


\$1.50 per person on weekdays; \$2.00 per person on Sundays
and holidays. Annual Fees, family group \$35.00, Individual
Fees \$50.00. Local residents paying \$2.00, fees will apply
to Annual Membership. This recommendation was unanimously
accepted by the Board.

The Board set up a Set up a Street Paving Program, whereby,
the residents would pay one half the cost for the Street
bordering their property, The Town of Lake Lure would pay
one half the cost. The deadline for applications for 1960
was set for August 25. All applications will be carefully
considered by the Board, the decision will be left to the
Board as to which street is in greatest need of paving. All
money must be in Town Office before any work is begun on a
Street.

Streets and roads will be paved as money becomes available
for street work.

No other business the meeting adjourned.
