The first item of business, the Board discussed the

The Clerk was instructed to have cards printed showing
the Playing rates: Daily rates \$2.00, Groups of five or
more, \$25.00 each, husband and wife team \$35.00, and
individual rate \$50.00 per season, the season rates
begin July 1 of each year. Memberships are not to be
transferred to another person.


The Board agreed to give \$25.00 to the Hickory Nut
