

The Regular Meeting Of The Board Of Commissioners Of
The Town Of Lake Lure Met In The Town Hall, Tuesday
Evening March 12, 1963, At 7:30 P.M.,

The Mayor welcomed Mr. Gilreath of Flat Rock, N.C. to the meeting. Mr. Gilreath was interested in obtaining the sand rights on the Lake, he promised to pump all the sand that the Town needed for the beach area and to keep the pumps in operation at all times unless the weather was such that he could not pump.

The Town promised Mr. Gilreath that, if it could be worked out with Justice Sand and Stone Co. whereby he could buy the Sand Barge and Pump, the Board would further discuss the leasing of the Sand Rights on the Lake. No definite decision was given.

The business of the Town was in order.

The Minutes were approved.

The 1963 Municipal Election to be held May 7, 1963.

Plans for the election were discussed and made, a resolution was drawn up and signed by the Mayor and the Clerk. The Resolution to be posted at the Town Hall for the forth coming election. A copy of the Resolution to be included in the Minutes.

The Board appointed the following people to serve as election Officials, Clyde W. Keeter, Registrar, J.V. Bell, Judge and Eugene Melton, Judge. Mr. Keeter will be paid \$150.00 for his services as Registrar and the Judges will be paid \$15.00 for the one day they serve as Judges.

Commissioner Franks made the Motion that the foregoing people serve as Registrar and Judges, the Motion was unanimously carried.

The final filing date was set for April 20, 12:00 O'Clock Noon, Saturday April 20, 1963.

Alternate Judges will be appointed if for any reason the present Judges cannot serve.
